



PERSONAL TRANSMITTER - S37

OVERVIEW:

The S37 personal transmitter sends a radio transmission to various types of wireless receivers, indicating alarm/message visually and audibly. The S37 personal transmitter supervises itself with the LifeCheck™ feature that assures the facility that the transmitter is functioning properly. The S37 personal transmitter is lightweight, waterproof and available in wrist or pendant style.

Operation:

A simple push of the button will send a "call for help" radio transmission to any or all of the following wireless receivers:

- NCL2 Local/Repeater Unit
- NCM2 Main Control Unit
- LE9 Multipurpose Receiver

A red diode above the button will illuminate whenever a "call for help" is transmitted. Calls can be cancelled remotely (option) or at the S37 via a wireless cancellation device (S37R) by authorized personnel.
